As you are aware, State / UT level Environment Impact Assessment Authority (SEIAA) has been constituted by the Central Government in your State under sub-section (3) of Section 3 of the Environment (Protection) Act, 1986. A copy of the notification constituting this Authority in your State / UT is enclosed.

2. As per the scheme of things under the Environment Impact Assessment Notification, 2006, as amended from time to time, while this Ministry deals with the environment clearance (EC) cases of category 'A' projects, the SEIAA deals with category 'B' projects. The EC letters issued by MoEF / SEIAA contain a number of conditions which need to be monitored. MoEF has six Regional Offices which monitor the conditions of ECs granted for various projects in different sectors spread throughout the country. We are now in the process of increasing the number of Regional Offices to ten with a view to further strengthening the monitoring activity.

3. As this Ministry has put in place a mechanism, through its Regional Offices, for monitoring the conditions of ECs granted by it, SEIAAs also need to put in place an appropriate mechanism to monitor the conditions stipulated in the ECs issued by them in respect of the projects in the State. As you are aware, the secretarial assistance to SEIAAs is provided by the concerned State Governments. The State Governments would also need to help SEIAAs in putting in place this mechanism. The monitoring mechanism would essentially involve visiting the sites of various projects, verifying the compliance of conditions stipulated in the ECs and sending the reports to the SEIAA for taking further necessary action. This monitoring work could perhaps be given to the State Pollution Control Board (including their Regional Offices) and / or an appropriate mechanism may be put in place by the State Government in consultation with SEIAA. The monitoring mechanism may be such that it is able to regularly monitor all the projects for which ECs have been issued by SEIAA in the State at reasonable intervals. Besides such monitoring, SEIAA may also obtain mandatory six monthly monitoring reports from the project proponents as prescribed under EIA Notification. Further, all monitoring reports may be uploaded on the website of SEIAA and a linkage of their website provided to this Ministry's website.

4. We are separately considering delegating appropriate powers to SEIAA under section 5 of the Environment (Protection) Act, 1986 as also authorization under sub-section (a) of Section 19 of the Act with a view to making the monitoring of ECs granted by them effective by way of ensuring compliance of the underlying conditions.



In addition to the aforesaid proposed monitoring mechanism by SEIAA, it has been decided that the concerned Regional Office of MoEF would also do random monitoring of the projects for which SEIAA has granted ECs. During a year, the concerned Regional Office may do such monitoring in respect of about 10% of the average of the number of ECs granted by SEIAA during the last three years. Such random checking would envisage covering the entire State to the extent possible and the projects in different sectors.

6. I shall be grateful if you could kindly look into the matter and facilitate putting in place at the earliest, a mechanism for monitoring of the ECs granted by SEIAA in your State. The details of the mechanism may kindly be shared with us.

का.आ.293(अ).—केन्द्रीय सरकार, पर्यावरण (संरक्षण) अधिनियम, 1986 (1986 का 29) की धारा 3 की उप-धारा (3) द्वारा प्रदत्त शक्तियों का प्रयोग करते हुए और भारत सरकार के पर्यावरण और वन मंत्रालय की अधिसूचना संख्या का.आ.1533(अ), तारीख 14 सितंबर, 2006 (जिसे इसमें इसके पश्चात् उक्त राजपत्र अधिसूचना कहा गया है) के अनुसरण में निम्नलिखित सदस्यों से मिलकर बनने वाले राज्य स्तर पर पर्यावरण समाघात निर्धारण प्राधिकरण (एसईआईएए), त्रिपुरा (जिसे इसमें इसके पश्चात् त्रिपुरा प्राधिकरण कहा गया है) का गठन करती है, अर्थात् :—

6. एसईएसी, त्रिपुरा के अध्यक्ष और सदस्य राजपत्र में इस अधिसूचना के प्रकाशन की तारीख से तीन वर्ष की अवधि के लिए पद धारण करेंगे ।

7. एसईएसी, त्रिपुरा ऐसी शक्तियों का प्रयोग और ऐसी प्रक्रिया का पालन करेगा जो उक्त राजपत्र अधिसूचना में प्रगणित है ।

8. एसईएसी, त्रिपुरा सामूहिक उत्तरदायित्व के सिद्धांत पर कार्य करेगा और अध्यक्ष प्रत्येक मामले में मतैक्यता पर पहुंचने का प्रयास करेगा और यदि मतैक्यता पर नहीं पहुंचा जा सकता है तो बहुमत की राय अभिभावी होगी ।

9. त्रिपुरा राज्य सरकार त्रिपुरा प्राधिकरण के लिए सचिवालय के रूप में कार्य करने के लिए एक अभिकरण को अधिसूचित करेगी और उसके सभी कानूनी कृत्यों की बाबत आवास, परिवहन और ऐसी अन्य सुविधाओं सहित उसे सभी वित्तीय और संभार तंत्र का समर्थन प्रदान करेगी ।

10. त्रिपुरा प्राधिकरण के अध्यक्ष और सदस्य और एसईएसी के अध्यक्ष और सदस्यों को त्रिपुरा राज्य सरकार के विद्यमान नियमों के अनुसार बैठक करने की फीस, यात्रा भत्ते और महंगाई भत्ते संदत्त किए जाएंगे ।

S.O. 293(E).—In exercise of the powers conferred by sub-section (3) of Section 3 of the Environment (Protection) Act, 1986 (29 of 1986) and in pursuance of the notification of the Government of India in the Ministry of Environment and Forests, number S.O. 1533(E), dated the 14<sup>th</sup> September, 2006 (hereinafter referred to as the said Gazette Notification), the Central Government hereby constitutes the State Level Environment Impact Assessment Authority (SEIAA), Tripura (hereinafter referred to as the Authority, Tripura) comprising of the following Members, namely:—

2. The Chairman and Members of the Authority, Tripura shall hold office for a term of three years from the date of publication of this notification in the Official Gazette.

3. The Authority, Tripura shall exercise such powers and follow such procedure as enumerated in the said Gazette notification.

4. The Authority, Tripura shall base its decision on the recommendations of the State level Expert Appraisal Committee (SEAC) constituted for the State of Tripura by this notification.

5. To assist the Authority, Tripura, the Central Government in consultation with the State Government of Tripura, hereby constitute the State level Expert Appraisal Committee, Tripura (hereinafter referred to as SEAC, Tripura) comprising of the following Members, namely:—

6. The Chairman and Members of the SEAC, Tripura shall hold office for a term of three years from the date of publication of this notification in the Official Gazette.

7. The SEAC, Tripura shall exercise such powers and follow such procedure as enumerated in the said Gazette notification.

8. The SEAC, Tripura shall function on the principle of collective responsibility and the Chairman shall endeavour to reach a consensus in each case, and if consensus cannot be reached, the view of the majority shall prevail.

9. The State Government of Tripura shall notify an agency to act as Secretariat for the Authority, Tripura and the SEAC, Tripura and shall provide all financial and logistic support including accommodation, transportation and such other facilities in respect of all its statutory functions.

10. The sitting fee, travelling allowance and dearness allowance to the Chairman and Member of the Authority, Tripura and the Chairman and Members of the SEAC, Tripura shall be paid in accordance with the existing rules of the State Government of Tripura.
